#### 3rd Grade Weekly Spelling List

This 5-week spelling program is designed to help 3rd graders improve their spelling skills gradually. Each week introduces new words, focusing on common patterns, tricky spellings, and advanced vocabulary.

Day	Activity
Day 1	Word Introduction & Reading Practice Read through the spelling list. Say each word out loud and discuss its meaning. Try using each word in a sentence.
Day 2	Write & Repeat Write each spelling word three times to reinforce letter patterns. Use the "Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check" method.
Day 3	Fill-in-the-Blanks & Word Matching Complete activities such as missing letters, word scrambles, or matching words to definitions.
Day 4	Sentence Writing & Application Write a sentence for each spelling word to understand its context. Try to use at least two words per sentence.
Day 5	Spelling Test  Take the weekly spelling test without looking at the word list. Write each word from memory. Parents/teachers can dictate the words.
